## **Consumer Price Index – FEBRUARY 2022**

The Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Government of Karnataka, Bangalore have published Consumer Price Index for Industrial Workers in Karnataka for the month of February <u>- 2022</u> in respect of 16 Centers. The base year for 9 centers with State series have been revised from 1987-88=100 series to 2018=100 series with effect from February 2022 and 7 Centers with Central series. Chikmangalore has been added in the Central series for the first time. Harihar Centre which was hithertoShown in the State series has been deleted. Linking factor for Chikmangalore has not been given in the notification published by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics Government of Karnataka. The Centers in State series and Central series are as follows:

## NOTE:

- 1. **C.P.I.** Figures in respect of 1960=100 / 2001=100 base can be arrived at by multiplying the Index Number by linking factor.
- 2. The Consumer Price index **[CPI]** of a particular Centre can be used to know the difference in average CPI of that particular Centre from time to time but cannot be used to compare between Centre to Centre.
