**GARMENT INDUSTRY ALLOWED TO OPERATE AT
50% DURING CLOSE DOWN**

KEA had written a letter to the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Karnataka on behalf of the Garment Industry to allow garment factories to work at 50% strength similar to other industries during the close down. Many other industry bodies and chambers had also made similar request to the Government.

Heeding to the request made by KEA and other industry bodies and chambers, the Government has now permitted garment factories to operate at 50% strength strictly adhering to COVID 19 appropriate behaviour.


ADDENDUM-3

In continuation of the Government order No. RD 158 TNR 2020, dated 26-04-2021, and in exercise of powers conferred under Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chairman, State Executive Committee, hereby issues an addendum to the guidelines to break the chain of COVID 19 transmission in the State, as below, for strict implementation by the Chief Commissioner BBMP, Police Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners, Superintendents of Police of the districts, and other Heads of Departments and Authorities.

Modification to sub clause (a) of Clause 11 pertaining to operations of Industries/Industrial Establishment in Annexure I of the guidelines:

The sub clause (a) of Clause 11, to be read as follows:

“All Industries/Industrial Establishments/ production units are permitted to operate adhering to Covid appropriate behavior. ***However, garment manufacturing units will operate with 50% of its workforce strictly adhering to COVID 19 appropriate behavior.*** The movement of staff shall be allowed by producing valid ID/authorization issued by concerned industries/industrial establishment.”
