# EPFO EASES THE PROCEDURE FOR JOINT REQUEST UNDER PARAGRAPH 26(6) OF EPF SCHEME

- 1. Paragraph 26(6) of the EPF Scheme permits employees to contribute to the Provident Fund over and above the statutory salary limit prescribed under the EPF Scheme. The following requirements should be satisfied.
  - A joint request in writing by an employee of the establishment to which the scheme applies for contributing on higher wages.
  - The employer should enrol such employee as a member or allow him to contribute to the provident fund on salary more than Rs.15,000/-per month the salary limit for coverage under the EPF Scheme.
  - The employer should give an undertaking in writing to the EPFO that employer shall pay the administrative charges payable and shall comply with all statutory provisions in respect of such employee.
- 2. The EPFO Head Office with a view to reduce time and paper consumption have laid down the revised formats to be filed and processed in a digital mode for all new cases prospectively.
  - All cases where employees have already contributed on pay more than the statutory salary limit, the employer has also paid

administrative charges on such contribution made on pay more than statutory limit but had left the employment or died till 31.10.2023 it will be deemed that such cases had been allowed for contributing on pay more than statutory limit so as to avoid hassles for concerned stake holder.

- All the existing members who are already contributing on pay more than statutory limit and their employers are also paying administrative charges on such contribution made on pay more than statutory limit will not be required to file their joint request in the above format immediately.
- 3. The internal circular issued by EPFO Head Office to their field functionaries dated: 30.1.2024 is enclosed. The circular also contains the format for joint request under para 26(6) of the EPF Scheme for existing employees, for new employees and the format of undertaking by the employer.

The above measure is applicable only for the cases under paragraph 26(6) of the EPF Scheme. The case of pension on higher wages under the decision of the Supreme Court judgment dated: 4.11.2022, the request and declaration shall be in the format as circulated by KEA vide its circular No.73/2023 dated: 15.6.2023.

Subject: Implementation of the Digital Joint Request under Para 26 (6) of the EPF Scheme, 1952- reg.

Madam/Sir,

The Joint Request and Permission under Para 26 (6) of the EPF Scheme, 1952 is a pre-requisite for an employee to contribute on a Pay more than the statutory limit. Accordingly, a format to prefer the Joint Request under Para 26(6) of the EPF Scheme, 1952 has been approved by the CBT in the 234<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 31/10/2023.

 With a view to reduce time and paper consumption, the format as enclosed herewith shall be filed and processed in digital mode for all new cases prospectively.

ii. All such cases where the employees had already contributed on Pay more than the statutory limit and the employer had also paid administrative charges on such contribution made on Pay more than the statutory limit but had left the employment or died till 31/10/2023, it is deemed that such cases had been allowed for contributing on Pay more than the statutory limit so as to avoid hassles for the concerned stakeholders.

All the existing members who are already contributing on Pay more than the statutory limit and their employers are also paying administrative charges on such contributions made on Pay more than the statutory limit will not be required to file their Joint Requests in the above format immediately.

It is re-iterated that the above measure is only for the cases under Para 26 (6) of EPF Scheme, 1952. The cases of Pension on Higher Wages under the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 04.11.2022 are already covered under the earlier Head Office Circular No.Pension/PoHW/23/Circular-26(6)/139610/1648 dated 14.06.2023.
