**EPFO INITIATIVE FOR LIQUIDATION OF INOPERATIVE PF
ACCOUNTS – REQUEST FOR NECESSARY ACTION**

The Association has received a communication from the Office of the Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner, Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO), Regional Office, Yelahanka, regarding a focused outreach initiative for liquidation of inoperative Provident Fund (PF) accounts and KYC seeding of such accounts.

EPFO has informed that it is undertaking a concerted effort to identify and facilitate the settlement of inoperative PF accounts belonging to employees covered under establishments within its jurisdiction. In this regard, trade bodies and employer associations have been requested to disseminate awareness among their member establishments and encourage employees having inoperative PF accounts to regularise and claim their dues.

Members are requested to advise concerned employees, wherever applicable, to undertake the following actions:

- Generate or link their Universal Account Number (UAN) with the respective PF account.
- Update KYC particulars such as Aadhaar, PAN and Bank Account details.
- Submit eligible claims for settlement or transfer of PF accumulations, wherever applicable.





Timely completion of the above activities will facilitate seamless access to provident fund accumulations and related member services and help avoid delays in future claim processing.

Members requiring any clarification or assistance may contact the concerned EPFO Regional Office.

- Submit eligible claims for settlement/transfer, wherever applicable.

Any assistance required in this regard may be sought from this office. Timely completion of the above activities will facilitate seamless access to provident fund accumulations and related member services, and will help avoid unnecessary delays in future claim processing.

The matter is receiving due attention at appropriate levels; hence, early cooperation in this regard shall be highly appreciated.
